

4. SANParks comments and provides advice through various ecological and governance structures.
5. MTPA and Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism, (LEDET) approve and issue permits for areas open to KNP, including any further due diligence processes needed where information might be lacking.
6. Additional due diligence through MTPA and LEDET requires that SANParks be informed about amendments.
7. The lion was not hunted in KNP, but in Umbabat, a Nature reserve not managed by KNP, but regulated by the MTPA.
8. Procedurally, MTPA followed the Protocol and open conservation parties were informed that a permit was issued.

Parties within the Great Limpopo Transfrontier Conservation Area (GLTFCA) footprint will strive to improve on procedures and best practices pertaining to all facets of protected area management.
