

Response:

- (1) (a) and (b) The table below indicates the stipends paid to the different levels of volunteers appointed on the Kha Ri Gude Mass Literacy Campaign for the 2012, 2013 and 2014 campaigns.

Monitors and Co-ordinators who are employed on a 12 month contract receive the maximum stipend, which was R5 900 for the 2014 campaign.

- (2) (a) Volunteers are required to teach/train a class of 18 learners in order to receive a full stipend. However, classes for the blind and deaf accommodate a maximum of 5 learners due to the nature of learning and teaching for these learners.

The table below indicates the average number of learners for the 2012/13, 2013/14 and 2014/15 financial years. As indicated, a class cannot have more than 18 learners. The numbers in the 2014/15 year show a steep decline as a result of the recommendations from the Auditor General's report which were implemented to eradicate ghost and deceased learners.

(b) The table below indicates the lowest number of learners taught/trained by a volunteer in the 2012/13, 2013/14 and 2014/15 financial years.

The numbers in the table are low as they reflect the blind and deaf classes which have a maximum of 5 learners per class.

The numbers in the 2014/15 financial year show a decline as a result of the recommendations from the Auditor General's report which were implemented to eradicate ghost and deceased learners.
