- whether the families of the mineworkers who died were compensated: if so, what amount did each family receive? NW410E

- (1) Answers to questions (a), (b), (c) and (d) are recorded on the attached "MINES OCCUPATIONAL FATALITIES REPORT –

  JANUARY 2017 TO DECEMBER 2017"
- (2) Compensation of Occupational Injuries or diseases sustained by mineworkers is legislated under Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act No 130 of 1993 ("COIDA") and this legislation is administered by the Department of Labour. Based on this the Department of Labour has jurisdiction over compensation of mineworkers.
